


CAMP OF THE GOOD SHEPHERD 2016 SCHEDULE

Dental service continued in May with the arrival of Dr. Philip Anderson from Seattle, WA. Dr. Anderson came as his own 'team'! In his 7 days of service he provided: 72 fillings, 12 extractions, 6 pulpotomies, 33 sealants, 1 root canal, and taught two classes at the University. While personally treating children, he also oversaw 5th and 6th year students that were interested in helping the children from the Placement Centers at Orlat, Turnu Rosu and Agarbiciu. We are so thankful for all our Dental volunteers who blessed so many this spring!
